Re: Taxes + Income of Property.

After not hearing from you about the tax question I, on my mother's behalf paid fifty-six dollars and (56.89) eighty nine cents - the taxes on the property located in the municipality of Surrey - 1614 Pacific (King George VI Highway).

As I am going to St. George Williams College I would like to have the equivalent amount \$56.89 sent to me which I paid to Surrey as taxes. Can you tell me what the income off the property above is?

I wrote to the commission about the taxes and having not heard from them I paid for the taxes myself now I would like the amount returned to me.

Please credit this amount to my account at the Bank of Montreal, Drummond + St. Catherine St's Branch as it was there then I paid my taxes for my mother, Mrs. T. Hoshiko 502 176 Selkirk Alta.

As a College student this sum means a lot to me and I would appreciate it if you would send it to me as soon as possible.
