



PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

This file reveals that Mrs. YAMADA owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: Mrs. YAMADA made her declaration to the Custodian on Oct. 27/42 and was evacuated on Oct. 30/42. She declared chattels as shown on the Chattel Schedule on file. The glove machines were appraised and advertised for sale by tender but no bids were received. Appraisal fee of \$5.00 and advertising costs of \$6.67 were deducted from her credit with the Custodian.

Other articles, as shown on Schedule, were sold by Bill of Sale for the sum of \$26.00 and this sum credited to her account. The barber chair was sold at auction for the net sum of \$3.46 and this sum also credited to her account.

In her letter of Jan. 24/46 she added a carpet to list of goods declared. The chairs, table, sofa, gas stove and this carpet were apparently not found by the Custodian, and neither the file of Mr. or Mrs. YAMADA give any information regarding these articles. A hardwood cabinet declared by her husband is also among the goods not found. I have checked the file of Asataro YOSHIDA, File 3311, who owned the property at 59 Powell St. and cannot see any chattels credited to him that would appear to belong to Mrs. YAMADA.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES:

According to information supplied to this office the fishing vessel the "HAMANA" was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$742.50 and this sum paid to Mrs. Shin YAMADA on March 13/42. However it was reported that the actual owner of the vessel was Ihei YAMADA, her husband. Full details are given on Specified Articles Summary on file.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
