Mr. Sam Watanabe (Tashme) - Isamu WATANABE, Reg. No. 07396

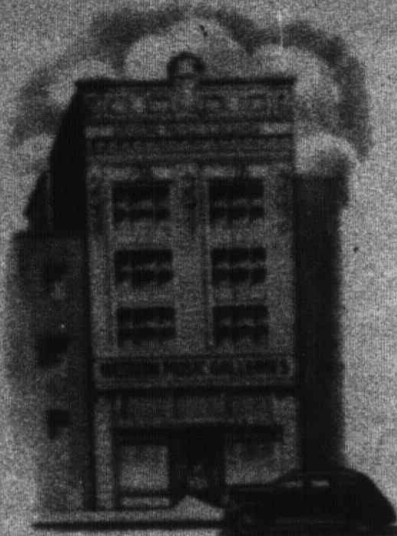
If so, our records do not reveal that these persons have been repatriated.

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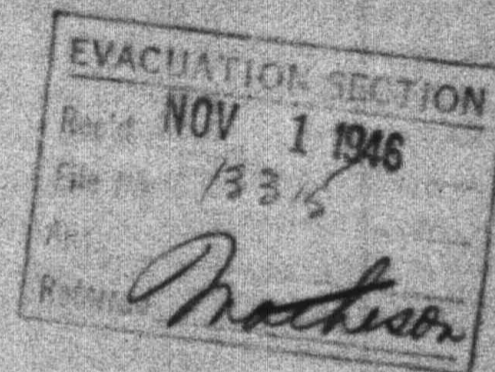
