We are in receipt of a letter from Mrs. Anne C. Kelly of Vancouver, B. C., who is known to the above named internee and she writes as follows:

"Mr. and Mrs. Asano asked me to accept, in the name of friendship of several years a table radio which they possessed which they could no longer keep and which they said would not be worth much if sold; and they wanted me to have it, as I had no radio of my own.

They also asked me to accept a camera; but was understood where this concerned that they expected to regain possession of it after the war, if they should want to.

Six weeks ago I received a letter from Mrs. Asano asking me to forward the camera to her in the East. I have not done this as I was not sure of the legality of sending a camera to an enemy alien."

Kindly pass this internee and have him advise us if he approves of our sending the camera in question to Mrs. Asano at Gault, Ontario.
