Dear Sir:

We have been advised by the Department of Labour, Japanese Division, that the above named Japanese, who, prior to emigration resided at 1277 Centre Street, New Westminster, died on July 6, 1945, at New Haven, B. C., and we are writing to request that you kindly undertake the administration of his Estate.

We are enclosing herewith copy of a letter received from his widow, Mrs. Hans YAMAMOTO, together with a list of particulars forwarded by her, the original Will in Japanese, and a certified copy of an English translation.

Our file indicates that the decedent was married twice and left his surviving the following:

Children by his first wife, who is deceased:

1. Mrs. George YAMAMOTO, daughter, c/o Bart & Peterson, Skinkin, B. C., aged 34 years.
2. Mrs. George YAMAMOTO, daughter, c/o Bart & Peterson, Skinkin, B. C., aged 30 years.
3. Yachiyo YAMAMOTO - In Japan.

Children by his second wife, Mrs. Hans YAMAMOTO, widow,  
Sloam, B. C., aged 30 years.

2. Yuriko YAMAMOTO, daughter, Sloam, B. C., aged 17 years.

We are informed by the I.C.I.P., that the above named survivors were either born in Canada or became naturalized Canadians with the exception

of Drs. Haruyo Taniya, Mrs. Hideo Yoshikawa, and Yoshiyo Teramura,  
who are Japanese Nationals.

Assets of the deceased, of which we have knowledge, is  
a credit balance with the Custodian, amounting to \$239.11.

We have on file a claim of Messrs. H. Nishiguchi Company  
limited for \$269.73, for merchandise supplied prior to occupation  
and during the years 1940, 1941 and 1942. This firm states that  
they have a Demand Note, dated May 8, 1942, covering this indebted-  
ness and also have an acknowledgment from him to the effect that he  
received certain goods.

You will note Item 11 in the enclosed memorandum of  
particulars, dated September 5, 1945, that Mrs. Teramura under 11 (2)  
wrote as follows:

"Due to an understanding between myself and the creditor this matter is  
to be ignored, therefore I have signed it."

We are not certain, but this may refer to the matter outlined in Mrs.  
Teramura's letter, dated August 24, 1945, a copy of which we are  
attaching hereto for your information.

We will be pleased to have you advise us as to your willing-  
ness to act in this matter and when Letters of Administration have been  
issued to you, kindly forward a certified copy to this office, so that  
we may remit the funds now in our hands.
