Re: Tsuneo MORI.

We have received the attached letter written in Japanese by Tsuneo Mori. A translation of this letter made by Mr. E.C. Hamigar, the Postal Censor is as follows:

"Greetings - Two years ago, viz. 3rd of February 16th year of Showa (1941) when on my way to Stillada (?) I was placed by white men, in Escondale. As yet I have had no trial. I am asking a very difficult matter I know, but will you kindly look into my case at once. I have not been ill at all up until this month. Please be very quick about this. There is more I would like to write but I will wait until I see you."

This would appear to be correspondence intended for your Department and is forwarded for your kind attention.
