I am a British subject having been born in the city of Vancouver, B.C. on March 6th, 1918. Just prior to evacuation of all peoples of Japanese ancestry on the Pacific coast I was attending school in Portland, Ore.

I am now under the War Relocation Authorities, and am filing application to leave the United States and return to Canada to rejoin my family who are evacuated to Kaslo, B.C.

I have no property remaining in the protected area.
