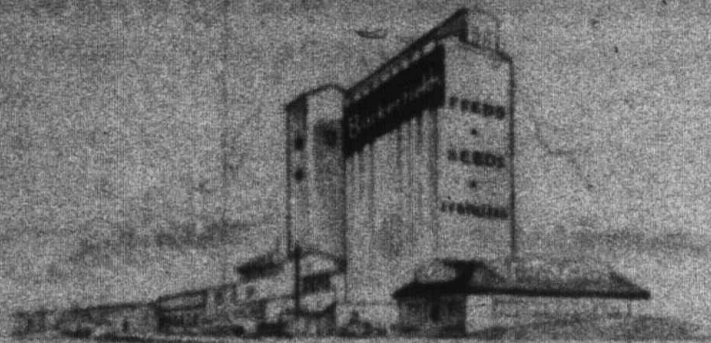

Thank you for your co-operation relative to this matter.

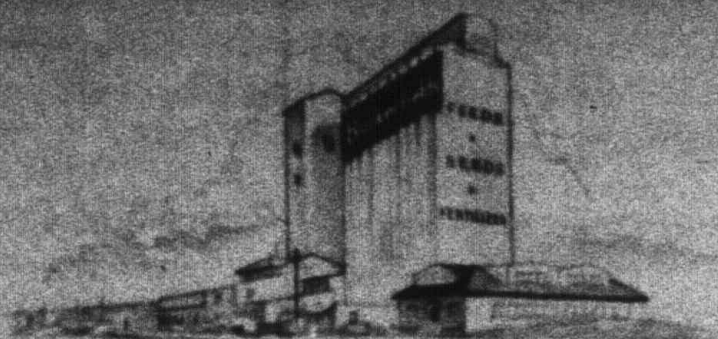
