

Dear Sir:-

Further to ours of April 20th, we regret that we have very little to report about the two nets that are missing. Number 775 (the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " mesh net) can definitely not be found. As previously mentioned, however, we have on our file particulars of this net and of your claim and while we do not know how matters like this will be handled, the question can later be reopened if some decision is come to in this connection.

Your net No. 773, the 7" mesh net, is still at the Gulf of Georgia Cannery but without the lines. The net itself is now valueless as would be expected after this period of time but the lines we fear, must have been stolen. Here again, there is nothing more we can say for the time being, but we have a record of the particulars of this case.

We fear you will find the above disappointing and regret that we have not better news to report.

MEMORANDUM

Re: Netora SHIYOJI

I do not usually ask you to trace nets left in the Gulf of Georgia Cannery as there are very few unaccounted for due to the care and efficiency of Mr. Townsend. In this case, however, I would like you to make a check of the following.

Custodian No. 775: 4/40 x 5 1/2 x 55 - 20, valued at \$100.00. I think this was taken to our storeroom and must be a case of loss by theft or tag switching.

Custodian No. 773: 6 x 7 x 45 - 135, valued at \$90.00, being \$60.00 for the web and \$30.00 for the lines. Our records show that this was not removed to the Custodian store in the final inventory being left with the Gulf of Georgia Cannery, shed No. 1. Would you check to see if there is any record of it on their books?

Dear Sirs:-

Re: Your File No. 13520.

I wish to acknowledge with thanks your favor of 20th ultimo, however, I have greatly disappointed in knowing that you have nothing to add for the time being in regard to my Salmon Gill Nets.

Being living in a self-supporting centre since the Evacuation Order, together with my aged parents and further, expecting another addition to my family, I am very anxious to obtain a reasonable income from any property that I have left behind. And for this reason, while it may seem impudent to you, please permit to write you again in the matter.

While I realize the difficulty experienced by you in tracing this matter due to my late filing of the information pertaining the nets, please recall that some time in March, 1943 I wrote to Mr. Townsend of Gulf of Georgia Cannery, Steveston, who then refer the matter to you. At that time, the nets known to you as:

#775 6 Ply x 7" Mesh - 45 MD. 135 Fms.

#775 4/40 x 5 1/2" " - 55 MD. 200 "

were said to be still unsold, the inference is that definitely they were accounted for. However, especially evident in the case of #775, knowing that any fisherman will not require it until the cycle year of 1945, I felt that these nets were still unsold. If my assumption is wrong, were these nets being stolen or sold and credited to some other person?

I would be greatly appreciated if you will kindly look into the matter further and advise me at your convenience.
