We have received from Messrs. Davidson & Guinet affidavit in proof of a judgment for \$257.45 obtained on November 10th, 1937 and bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum subsequently against the Chilliwack Growers Produce Ltd. and Koichi MIYAMOTO, who is described as a "chauffeur," an individual of the Japanese race and one whose address was unknown to the claimants in April, 1942.

Would you be good enough to provide us with some information if it is known to you regarding Mr. Koichi Miyamoto whose name may perhaps be spelled Miyamoto. Do you have his present address or can you suggest a source from whom his address may be secured? We do not appear to have received the Registration of this Japanese individual and the files of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police have also been searched without avail. What is the present position of the judgment obtained by A. Ball, Rebecca Ball, Myrtle Drinkwater, D. Finlayson, and Frank Ball?
