PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

File No. 13562

October 26, 1946.

Re: Kamekichi MORISHITA #07936

This man was evacuated on March 23, 1942, but did not sign a declaration to the Custodian until November 9, 1942.

The only property reported in his declaration was 2 sets of bed-ends, 2 bed-springs and 2 Coleman lanterns, all stored at the Japanese School, Nanaimo. On November 19, 1942, there were shipped to the wife of this man, 2 bundles of bed-ends, 2 springs and one bundle of rails. This would appear to account for the bed-ends and springs declared. The two Coleman lanterns seem to be accounted for in Auction Chemainus #1, when lanterns, identified as the property of this man, were sold for the net sum of \$1.62, which has been credited to his account.

No other property of any kind whatsoever is revealed by this file.

This summary is certified to be in accordance with information on file.
