We wish to inform you that the above-named Japanese national (born March 27, 1898) is reported to have been confined in the Resondale Mantal Hospital on April 28, 1942, while under the control of the B. G. Security Commission.

Proceeds from sale of property belonging to Tesukichi Goto which vested in the Custodian at the time of the Evacuation amount to \$570.84. We understand that the circumstances require that this money be turned over to the Attorney General for administration and we are therefore enclosing Custodian chaque No. 7519 for \$570.84, together with a statement showing how this sum is made up.

This office has no knowledge of debts owing by this man nor is aware of other assets, with the possible exception of Sun Life Assurance Palicy No. 2205567 which did not come under the control of the Custodian and concerning which no action has been taken.

Royal Canadian Mounted Police Records obtained at the time of the Evacuation give this man's family as follows:
