PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

RE: Kazuo SHIMIZU, Reg. No. 01821

This file reveals that SHIMIZU owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: He made his declaration to the Custodian on March 22/43 and was evacuated March 14/42. He declared no chattels.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: He declared a 1933 Ford car. This was sold for the net sum of \$78.02 and this sum credited to his account with the Custodian. A Custodian cheque for this sum was remitted to SHIMIZU on April 7/43.

MONEYS RECEIVABLE: The records of the Kawade Box Co. showed the sum of \$235.75 owing to T. SHIMIZU. We wrote to Tsugio SHIMIZUE, Int. 1056, and asked if this money was owing to him. He advised us that the money was owing to his brother, Tommy Kazuo SHIMIZU. We wrote to Mr. Kazuo SHIMIZU regarding the matter and he advised us in his letter of April 1/43 that he had received the sum of \$160.00 from the Kawade Box Co. and that there was approximately \$75.00 still owing to him. This information was passed on to the Canadian Credit Men's Trust Association who were handling the affairs of the Kawade Box Co. On August 30/43 we received from the Canadian Credit Men's Trust Association the sum of \$10.45 to be credited to the account of Kazuo SHIMIZU. This represented a 17½% distribution which was being paid to the creditors of the Kawade Box Co. This is the only credit SHIMIZU still has with the Custodian.


At the request of SHIMIZU and with the permission of the Custodian, the Yorkshire Savings & Loan Assn. sent us a cheque in the sum of \$232.30 in favour of Kazuo SHIMIZU and his mother Mrs. Kogiku KOBAYASHI. This represented the cash withdrawal value of the 10 "S" 15-year Plan Endowment Instalment Shares held by Kazuo SHIMIZU and his mother. Custodian cheque for this amount was remitted to Kazuo SHIMIZU on Jan. 14/44. The cheque was made out jointly to Kazuo SHIMIZU and his mother.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.

With reference to your letter of the 15th of November, we would advise that we have now received from the Yorkshire Savings & Loan Association a cheque for \$232.30, being, as they state, the cash withdrawal value of 10 "A" 15-Year Plan Endowment Instalment Shares held by you and Mrs. Kogiku Kobayashi, less 7 per cent Normal Tax. 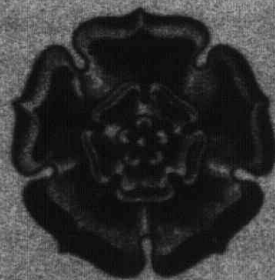

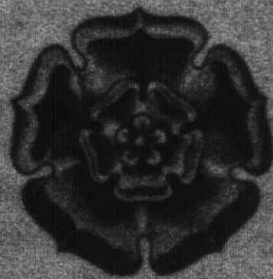
