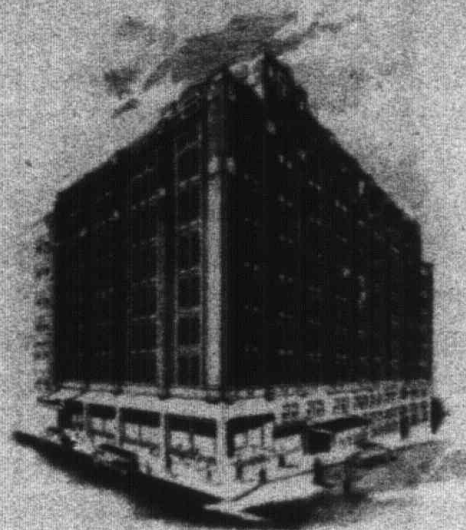

We enclose herewith a statement of our account against the estate of S. Morita of 1876 Powell Street. This account was incurred when Mr. S. Morita was operating a Grocery Store at this location, and business was continued by his wife after his death.

It has been very difficult to obtain any money from these people for a number of years, and it is however possible that under present conditions some means might be found to liquidate any assets connected with the business.
