Security Commission, with the request that it be transmitted by them to you in the regular way. You may, therefore, anticipate receiving said cheque either at the time you receive this letter or shortly thereafter.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you also that we have been successful in obtaining from the Provincial Collector for you a refund of \$5.63, representing 1% wage deductions for the first six months of 1941, and that this sum of \$5.63 has been credited to your account with us. We fail to have any record, however, of your having registered your assets with the Custodian, and you may, therefore, expect to hear from the Registration Department of this office in this connection shortly. They will be sending you the necessary forms, which please complete and return to us as soon as possible.
