Purely in order that our records may be complete, would you please secure from Mr. Ryosaburo Kikagawa the full name of his wife and her present address in Japan. When Mr. Kikagawa registered his assets with the Custodian on March 13, 1943, he declared to us that he was married and that his wife was in Japan, but he did not provide us either with her name or with her full address in Japan. According to the records here in Vancouver of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, Mr. Ryosaburo Kikagawa's wife is deceased and her name, according to their records, was Haru Kikagawa.
