

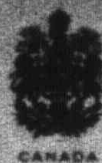

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on July 26, 1943, in which he reported ownership of no property of any kind.

His file reveals that a cheque for \$6.17 was sent to him from this office to cover the sum credited to his account as refund of 1% wage deduction for 1941. Remittance was made August 21, 1943.

The Department of Income Tax filed claim for \$53.28 payable by this man on March 11, 1943. As we had no account for Kametaro MORI, we advised the Department of Income Tax to communicate with him direct.

This file reveals no other assets or liabilities.
