

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.

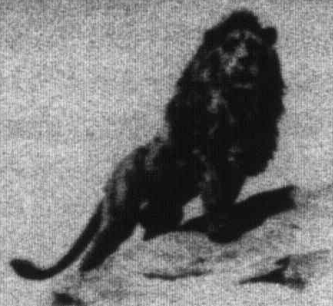
