GENERAL SUMMARY

RE: Hideo OKAMURA, Reg. No. 00099

Mr. OKAMURA was evacuated on March 2/42 and made his declaration to the Custodian on July 1/43. He declared only a Heintzman piano which he stated had been shipped to Prof. H. M. Johnson, Canadian Jr. College, Lacombe, Alta.

His account was credited with the sum of \$3.87 being a refund of 1½ wage deductions for the first six months of 1941. This was remitted to him on Feb. 22/43. He acknowledged receipt of it in his letter of March 2/43.

In July, 1945, his account was credited with the sum of \$1.76, being a refund of security deposit for light from the B.C.E.R. This is his only credit on hand with the Custodian.

There are no claims on file against Mr. OKAMURA. There are no claims on the file of his wife, Kasue, File 14654.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
