Replying to yours of the 26th ult. re the above, we did not reply to yours of the 19th of Pebruary sooner because we have only located the individual against whom you have a claim. We have been making enquiries from numerous sources, and have only now been able to locate him through the Statistical Division of the Provincial Board of Health, who inform us that KAMITOMA died on the 8th of October, 1940, We quote from their letters

"The deceased formerly lived at 2054 Dundas St., Vancouver, a farmer by occupation, aged forty-eight years, eleven months, and the cause of death was Pulmonary Tuberculosis. Dr. G. R. Barrett attended the deceased; the informant being his son, H. Kamitomo of 2054 Dundas St., Vancouver.

We have written to his wife, Mrs. Hide KAMITOMO and forwarded your claim. We are afraid, however, that the chances of your collecting are very remote, as as far as this office is aware his family have no assets and there is approximately \$800.00 owing by the estate.
