



It is noted that the above made his declaration to the Custodian on April 26th, 1942, and that he declared only 1 kitchen stove, 1 kitchen cabinet, 1 screen and 1 bed, left in a house belonging to the Imperial Brewery at Stoverton, where he had been living with his family. When our Stoverton representative went to remove the chattels on February 9th, 1943, he found the house empty and no trace of the chattels.

Some time later a Mrs. Morrival called at the office and advised that the above had stored his chattels at her home at 119 Stoverton Highway. These were found and removed to our auction rooms. These items are shown on the Schedule along with any other effects removed from this address on September 28th, 1944. They were sold as per inventory #39. This inventory included the carpenter's tools belonging to Keiji NITTA, File 13606, who had left them in the care of Bunzo SAKAMOTO.

At the time Mrs. Morrival called at this office to tell us of the effects belonging to the above which were stored in a barn owned by Yachiyo IANAHARA, File 4964, she stated that these goods had been stored by Taira SAKAMOTO, File 6432, a son of Bunzo SAKAMOTO. Therefore when these goods were sold, the net proceeds amounting to \$540.45, were credited to the account of Taira SAKAMOTO. After such correspondence with Taira SAKAMOTO and his father, Bunzo SAKAMOTO, it was determined that the goods really belonged to the father, Bunzo SAKAMOTO. Mr. Keiji NITTA agreed that we should send the total proceeds from sale of goods to Bunzo SAKAMOTO, and they would arrange between themselves what portion of this sum belonged to Keiji NITTA. The son Taira was also quite satisfied with this arrangement, therefore a cheque for the total credit balance is being sent to Bunzo SAKAMOTO with a reporting letter.

On April 2nd, 1945 we wrote to Mr. SAKAMOTO enclosing copies of our sales sheets showing goods sold and total net proceeds. He wrote on April 7th, 1945, listing a large number of items he stated were not included in our sales sheets. (These items are listed on Chattel Schedule). A copy of this letter was sent to Mrs. Morrival. She stated that she had turned over to the Custodian all goods belonging to Bunzo SAKAMOTO left in her care, and that no effects remained in the barn.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.

On Nov. 26/42, the above was sent J.P. forms to fill out. He replied on Dec. 4/42 stating that he had left all his belongings in the hands of Mr. Dunzo SAKAMOTO and was sending him the forms to complete. After further correspondence he wrote on March 16th, enclosing a yellow, "No property" card, which had been sent to him when he stated in his letter that he had nothing to declare.

He wrote again on March 25/45 authorizing us to pay to Dunzo SAKAMOTO the entire sum credited from the sale of chattels, which included those of the above, and which had been left in the care of Mr. SAKAMOTO. All the chattels found in Mrs. Morrival's barn were sold at auction and the proceeds credited to Mr. Dunzo SAKAMOTO, who has been identified as the owner.

We have not as yet received duly completed JP registration forms signed by you and ask that you give this matter your attention as soon as possible.

In your letter to us dated January 12th, written after you heard from Mr. Bunzo Sakamoto, you informed us that Mr. Sakamoto told you that none of your belongings were in the hands of the Custodian.

This appears to be a matter which you can best settle by communicating direct with Mr. Sakamoto as you yourself made your own arrangements with Mr. Sakamoto and we, in this office, have no record of any of your personal effects.

A letter we received sometime ago from Mr. Sakamoto states that he had helped you prepare your JP registration forms but that as he did not know the name of your youngest daughter he had returned the forms to you for completion on the understanding that you would be forwarding the forms to us.
