MEMORANDUM

To: Mr. E. W. Wright

October 1, 1942

Re: P/W A-680, TABATA, Hyozo and
Evacuee Tsunematsu ATAGI

Referring to your memo of September 28 re the above-numbered files, Tsunematsu Atagi in his registration form declares that he owns no property but lives with his son, Kaoru Atagi, at Steveston.

Kaoru ATAGI declares ownership with his brother, Hisao ATAGI, of Lot "B" of a 3 acre portion of Section 4, Block 3 North, Range 7 West, Map 3756; and also owns personally, Lots 13, 14 and 15, Block 17, Section 3, Block 3 North, Range 7 West, Map 249. Parcel #1 has several buildings located on it—a 7-room frame dwelling, 1 large boat house, 3 sheds, and a garage, all of which were built over 30 years ago and are in poor condition. Parcel #2 consists of 3 vacant lots.

There is another son, Osamu ATAGI who owns Lots 10, 11, and 12, Block 17 of Section 3, Block 3 North, Range 7 West, Map 249, on which there are no buildings.

We cannot understand what connection there is between Tsunematsu ATAGI and your Internee Hyozo TABATA, who you state is a brother.


LIABILITY SUMMARY

A claim was lodged against Ryozo Tabata on April 30, 1942, by the M. Furuya Co., in the amount of \$9.76. This claim was denied by Tabata so no further action was taken by the Custodian.

Another claim was lodged against Ryozo Tabata by Sajiro Wakita, on December 14, 1942, in the amount of \$41.17. Ryozo Tabata admitted this claim but stated he would settle directly with Wakita. No further action was taken by the Custodian.


There are no Cameras, radios, Fire Arms or Motor Vehicles revealed in the registration or the file.
