The above noted was interned April 21st, 1942, and his P/W A No. was 484. He was subsequently released and evacuated November 9th, 1942, to Port Arthur, Ontario, his present address.

According to his Declaration of April 4th, he left in the care of Hirochika Sumi, registration No. 07920, formerly of 1642 West 2nd Ave., two boxes of radio parts.

We have communicated with Mr. Sumi with a view to obtaining the present location of these parts, and have received Mr. Sumi's reply which states in part—"I think there must be an error as I have no recollection of taking care of Mr. Matsumoto's goods." We would appreciate any further information you may be able to supply in this connection.

Your courteous and prompt attention to this matter will be greatly appreciated.
