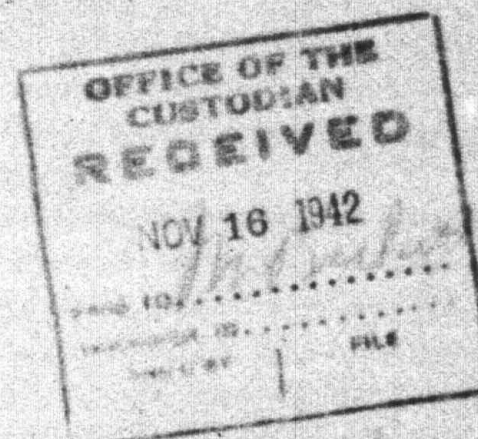

GENERAL SUMMARY

RE: Kazuo NAGAHARA, Reg. No. 02346

NAGAHARA made his declaration to the Custodian on April 9/42, was interned May 16/42 and released Nov. 9/42. On his first declaration he stated that he had left some clothing and a few books at his home, 1774 Powell St. However in a later, undated declaration, and in his letter of Feb. 7/43 he states he has no property remaining in the protected area.

His account was credited with the sum of \$1.53, which was a refund from the Provincial Collector of 1½ wage deductions for the first six months of 1941. This was remitted to him on Oct. 22/43.

At the time he was released from Angler Internment Camp he still had \$4.00 to his credit in the camp and this sum was remitted to our office to be credited to his account. This is his only credit with the Custodian.

There are no claims on file against him.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
