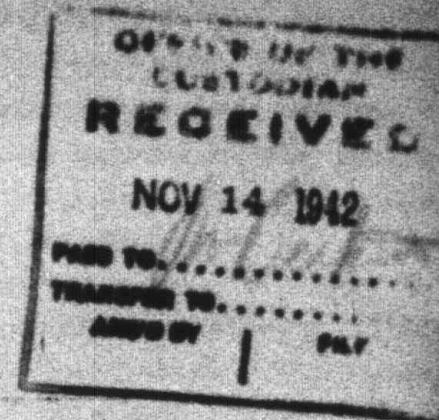

You declared the sum of \$20.60 surrendered to the Custodian at the time of your internment, and this amount was remitted to you on January 25th, 1943.

You also declared a life insurance policy with the Sun Life Assurance Co., and the cash surrender value amounting to \$314.95, was remitted to you on August 26th, 1943.

The above was interned on May 16th, 1942, and released from Internment Camp on November 9th, 1942.

MONEYS

RECEIVABLE:

The above, on his declaration dated January 10th, 1943, stated that the sum of \$20.60 had been left in trust by him at the Canadian Immigration Building in Vancouver. This amount was held for him by the Custodian and remitted to him on January 25th, 1943.

BANK

ACCOUNT:

The above declared an account in the Bank of Montreal, Main and Hastings Branch in the amount of \$9.00. On checking this with the Bank it was found that the balance was \$11.01, which sum was transferred from the Bank to the Custodian and credited to the account of the above in this office. A cheque for this amount is being remitted to him, closing out his account with this office.

LIFE

INSURANCE:

The above declared a policy with the Sun Life Insurance Co., but gave no further details. The Sun Life Co. advised us that this was Policy No. 2187642 in the amount of \$1000.00. We informed Yoshio KOZAI, through the Camp Commandant at Angler, that a premium of \$46.00 was due on his Sun Life policy and that we had no funds to his credit in this office with which to pay the account. We were then advised that he wished to have his policy changed to a paid up policy. This was done and on August 18th, 1943, the cash surrender value of the policy in the sum of \$314.95 was received in this office and was then forwarded to Yoshio KOZAI.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
