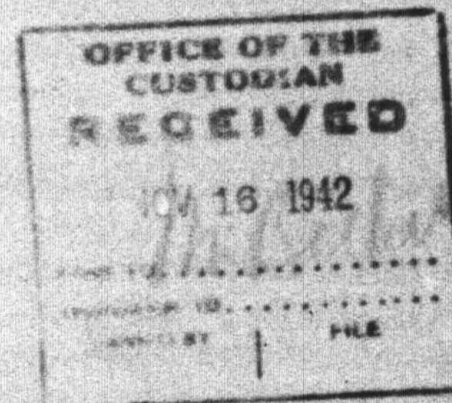

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

August 5, 1946.

Re: Yoshitaro OMOTO, Reg. No. 09597

This man was interned on June 13, 1942 and released on November 9, 1942. He signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 28, 1943, in which he reported that he owned no property of any kind in the protected areas.

At the time of his internment three \$10.00 War Savings Certificates were seized. These were surrendered on November 24, 1942 and the account of this man was credited with the sum of \$24.24 as redemption value of these Certificates.

While he was interned he reported owning three other War Savings Certificates of \$10.00 value in the possession of his mother, and as he was then a POW these were received from his mother. We are returning these to OMOTO today.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$3.36 received as refund of 1% wage deduction for 1941.

The Prudential Life Assurance Co. informed us that this man had a \$500.00 policy with that company. This did not come under the control of this office.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.
