

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 1, 1943 in which he reported that he owned no property of any kind in the protected area.

However, he appears to have had some interest in a radio, registered in the name of his brother and released to Mrs. Don Y. Liu on February 26, 1943 on SEKI's authorization.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$5.63 received as refund of 13 wage deduction for 1941. We are today remitting this amount to SEKI.
