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

CHATELS: The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on Dec. 21/42 and was evacuated on March 12/42, declared chattels at the Fairview Buddhist Temple, 715 West 7th Ave. as shown on Chattel Schedule on file. However before the Custodian could remove the chattels from this building direct to Willards auction room, the building was entered by thieves and vandals, so a number of chattels declared by the above were not found as will be noted from the Chattel Schedule. Goods that were found were sold at auction for the net sum of \$14.31 and this sum credited to the account of the above.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: This file reveals that the camera, a No. 1 pocket kodak, was surrendered to the R.C.M.P. by the above on March 12/42 and was handed over by them to the Custodian on July 11/44. This camera was shipped to the above at his request on Dec. 12/45 after the camera receipt was received in this office.

MONEYS RECEIVABLE: The sum of \$4.02 was received in this office from the Provincial Collector, being a refund of wage deductions for the first six months of 1941, owing to the above. This was credited to his account with the Custodian.

LIFE INSURANCE: Two insurance policies with the Prudential Insurance Company were surrendered by the above and cash surrender cheques in the sums of \$51.68 and \$61.22 were remitted direct to Mr. TANAKA by the Company on May 7th, 1946.

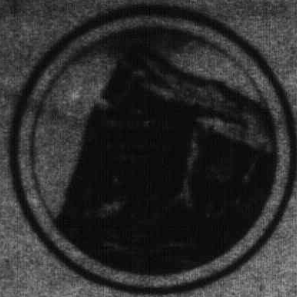
