MORI made his declaration to the Custodian on Dec. 19/42 and was evacuated on Feb. 23/42. He declared the following chattels left at the Japanese Language School at 151 W. 5th Ave.

2 trunks - shipped Oct. 26/45
1 bed - sold at auction
1 bureau - sold at auction
1 wooden box- unaccounted for.

MORI first asked for shipment of his trunks on Oct. 4/43 but they were not shipped until Oct. 26/45. MORI had sent us \$6.00 to pay shipping charges but through an error they were shipped "Collect". The \$6.00 was refunded to MORI on Dec. 3/45.

Two beds and one dresser removed from the japanese Language School were sold at auction on April 25/45 and the proceeds credited to the account of MORI. As however, he only declared one bed, and in several letters asked about his one bed and dresser, I am asking Miss Girard to transfer one bed to Chattel Suspense Account. The one bed and dresser sold for the net sum of \$16.01, and this is his only credit balance with the Custodian. There is a memo on file from Mr. Spain stating that one bed was discarded as being of no value. Since a number of Japanese left chattels at this school, this discarded bed and the one that has been transferred, might belong to anyone of them.


