I HAVE RECEIVED YOUR LETTER OF 23RD TO-DAY AND FAIL TO SEE WHY I HAVE TO FILL IN YOUR FORM ("JP") I HAVE ARRANGED WITH MY SISTER (FILE NO. 11271) MRS H. IWATA TO HAVE YOUR DEPARTMENT CONSIDER MY HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND ETC., AS MRS H. IWATA SO THAT IT WILL NOT COMPLICATE THE MATTER. AM I TO FILL IN ANOTHER OF MY "JP" FORM, I BELIEVE YOUR DEPT. WILL HAVE A VERY DIFFICULT TIME IN SEPARATING MY THINGS FROM HERS.

SINCE YOU HAVE NOT HAD THE EXPERIENCE WE HAVE GONE THRU PERHAPS IT WOULD BE DIFFICULT TO BELIEVE THAT I HAVE NO IDEA HOW OR WHAT PART OF THE HOUSE WE HAVE LEFT OUR BELONGING. AND I AM TOLD THAT AT THE TIME WE LEFT WHICH WAS SOON AFTER R.C.M.P. POSTED, THE NOTICE FOR ALL ENEMY ALIEN TO GET OUT OF PROTECTED AREA YOUR DEPARTMENT TO TAKE CARE OF SO CALLED ALIEN PROPERTY WAS NOT IN FUNCTION, WHICH IS PERHAPS THE REASON FOR OUR FAILURE TO REGISTER WITH YOU.

COULD YOU NOT SEND THE GOODS IN MRS H. IWATA HOUSE, TO MRS H. IWATA BY JUST CONSIDERING THE WHOLE THINGS AS HERS.
