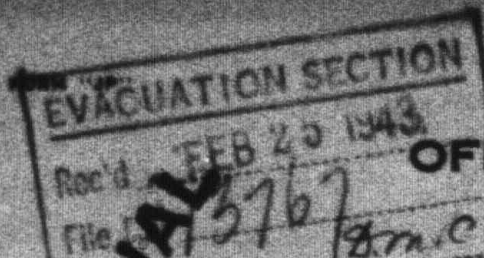

Re: Policy No. 2,245,570

We have received your letter of February 11th in which you mentioned about requesting a Paid-up Endowment sometime ago. We have written you on several occasions asking that you send in the policy and as it has not arrived we returned the Change Form to you a few days ago as they are not of no value.

The maximum cash loan you can obtain against your policy at the present time is \$10,000. If you take this loan it just means that next December you will have to pay the premium and interest if your circumstances are to be kept in force beyond that date. If you can not see any prospects of making this payment next December then it might be more advisable to take the cash surrender value that is available now. This cash surrender value is about \$11,000.

If you wish to take the loan then the attached loan agreement, (yellow form) is to be signed by you where marked "Assured" and by your father, Eikajiro Spyrans, where marked Beneficiary. Both signatures must be witnessed by someone outside the family who will sign directly opposite your signature and that of your father and will of course show his address and occupation. Should you prefer to take the cash surrender value then the attached application, (white form) should be signed in the same manner as the loan agreement except that the witness does not need to show his address and occupation. In either case, the policy must be furnished.

If you will send in the completed loan agreement or completed application for cash surrender value together with your policy, we will arrange to have the cheque for you from our Head Office in Montreal just as soon as possible.
