This man was evacuated on March 10, 1942. No declaration regarding his assets was signed by him prior to his evacuation.

On March 24, 1943, the Custodian received a cheque for \$72.96 from the Registrar of War Savings Certificates, payable to Yoshisuke MURATA, and on that date a letter was sent to MURATA, enclosing a JP form. He returned the JP form with a letter stating that he had no property remaining in the protected area. The letter carried the name Yoshisuke MURATA, Reg. No. 04861, typewritten, but no signature.

At MURATA's request, the \$72.96 was remitted to him on April 7, 1943.

The cameras and radio, shown on Specified Articles Memorandum, were reported by the RCMP as having been surrendered by this man. The radio was sold and the net proceeds credited to his account in the amount of \$86121. The cameras were mailed to Toshisuke MURATA on September 22, 1945. In proof of his ownership, he sent us the receipt which he had received from the RCMP when these articles were surrendered.
