In the first place we wish to correct your statement that we are acting as Poollection agents for the Provingial Board of Health" as such is not the case. All claims that are longed with us egainst debtors are handled by us in much the same way. We submit them to the debtors, and on receipt of their reply we pass the information on to the creditors, the same es we did in your case. To endeavour to have all claims andoebly settled, but the debter and the creditor must decide as to that. We are now in receipt of a reply from the Collector for the Provincial Board of Health; in order that it will be correctly reported to you we quote from it as follows: Theferring to your letter of May 11th, as I explained in my letter of May 16th, we accepted from Mr. Soga Sic.00 per month for a certain period and later he paid \$5.00 monthly, said payments being accepted as partial payments only. ie signed a contract form (copy of which I enclose) providing for payments on account at the rate set.
