GENERAL SUMMARY

RE: Minoru MATSUI, Reg. No. 00450

Minoru MATSUI did not register with the Custodian. He was evacuated on July 9/42.

In a letter dated Dec. 28/42 he asked if he might have a Mr. Woodley send him his ukelele which he had left in the upstairs front room of 617 Powell St. His mother Mrs. S. MATSUI, File 11187, owned the real property at this address. He also asked for a list of all goods stored at this address. We wrote to him asking him to give us the full name and address of Mr. Woodley. He did not reply giving us this information, but he did write to us on March 10/43 advising us that he had received his ukelele, so it would appear that he made his arrangements direct with Mr. Woodley. He also stated in this letter that all the goods at 617 Powell St. were under the name of his mother, Mrs. S. MATSUI. On checking the file of his mother it is noted that she had the tenant, Mr. Woodley, make shipments to her of chattels at 617 Powell St. so it is likely the ukelele was included in these shipments.

His account has been credited with the sum of \$6.00, being a refund of security deposit for light from the B.C.E.R. This is his only credit with the Custodian.

There are no claims on file against him.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
