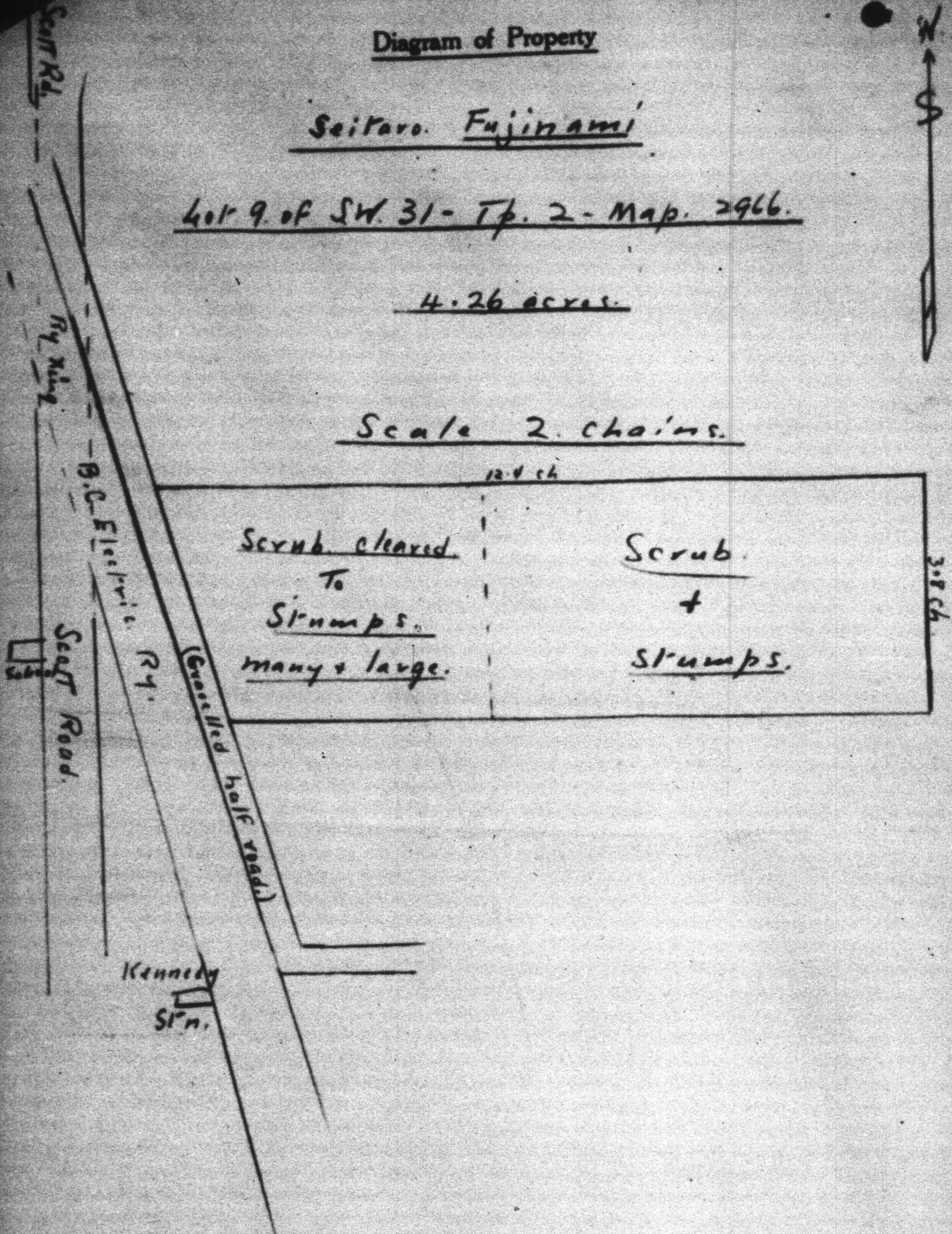

You have previously been advised that a sale of lands in rural districts was entered into between this Department and The Director, The Veterans' Land Act.

Due to the size of this transaction, the arrangements for same and the completion of the transfer have taken a considerable time. Negotiations were started in the early part of 1943 and were based upon valuations made by qualified appraisers and on the basis of a sale effective as at January 1st of that year. This means that the 1943 revenues from the property were for the benefit of the purchasers, but that taxes, fire insurance and other operating charges were assumed by them.





No chattels are involved on this file. There is a reference dated December 19th, 1941 (R. C. M. P.) to the effect that the contents of the house in which his wife resided were worth \$350.00.

The said contents, however, were declared by his wife and she has since admitted that they were disposed of by her before evacuation. Her file #4585 is now closed.

The above Japanese was interned in December, 1941, and at that time he was interviewed and he declared the following personal property assets:-

LIFE INSURANCE: He declared a \$1000. Manufacturers' Life Insurance policy, but as he was released in December, 1942, this was not brought under control by the Custodian.


BANK ACCOUNTS: He declared two bank accounts with the Royal Bank of Canada. One at the East End Branch, Vancouver, and the other at Port Alberni. As FUJINAMI's wife was in need of maintenance, we enquired of the Royal Bank East End branch, as to his credit balance, which was \$80.00, and the Royal Canadian Mounted Police advised us on the 29th January, 1942, that his wife had presented a cheque in this amount at their office for his signature, and this had been taken by Mrs. FUJINAMI, and the Bank later advised us of its being cashed.

The Royal Bank at Port Alberni stated that they had no account for FUJINAMI.

ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE: Seitaro FUJINAMI declared that Goro FUJINAMI owed him \$300.00, and when asked in a letter dated 18th February, 1943, whether it was still owing, he replied that the amount was only \$150.00. We wrote to Mr. Goro FUJINAMI in March, 1943, to which he replied that he did not owe as much as \$150.00. Seitaro FUJINAMI was advised of Goro FUJINAMI's reply, and he advised this office on the 8th April, 1943, that he would write to Goro and make some settlement. We have heard nothing further from either of the Japanese, and the Custodian has taken no further action in the collection of this account.

This file reveals no other personal property assets.

The above Japanese was interned in December, 1941, and at that time he was interviewed with regard to his liabilities.

He stated that he owed the following debts:

Filed against him at this office was a claim by Gihai KAWAHARA for \$185.29.

The first three claims were referred to him on the 18th February, 1943, after he had been released, as to how he intended to make settlement. He replied on the 2nd March and 8th April, that the Union Fish Company account was still outstanding, but that Maikawa & Co. had been paid. T. Maikawa & Co. were advised of this, and as they made no reply, it was assumed that FUJINAMI's statement was correct.

KAWAHARA's claim was referred to FUJIMOTO on the 9th May, 1944, and he was again asked about his debt to Masao MIYAMOTO. He replied on the 17th May, and denied owing anything to KAWAHARA, and stated that Masao MIYAMOTO had been paid direct. KAWAHARA was advised of FUJIMOTO's reply, and no further action was taken by the Custodian.

The Union Fish Company were paid \$20.20 on the 28th May, 1947, and asked to accept this amount in full settlement, as FUJINAMI had no other funds to his credit here.

1. The above named is at present in custody in the Canadian Immigration Detention Shed in Vancouver having been arrested as an alien enemy. He is 42 years old and is employed with the Bloedel Company at Port Alberni as a millworker. Subject lives at a boarding house in Port Alberni which is operated by one K. Ota. His wife and two small children reside in New Westminster, B.C. The wife's name is Kimiko.

2. Subject has been interviewed by the undersigned in an effort to obtain information as to his assets which might prove of assistance to the Custodian of Alien Enemy Property in the administration of his affairs.

3. This man has a bank account with the East End Branch of the Royal Bank of Canada in Vancouver with a balance of about \$70. He also has a savings account with the Royal Bank of Canada in Port Alberni with a small balance. He has no safety deposit box. He has a life insurance policy with the Manufacturers Life for \$1000. which he has held for only one year. He also has an accident and sickness policy at his home in Port Alberni but cannot recall the name of the company with whom this is carried.

4. Fujinami has no investments such as stocks or bonds. He owns five acres of land in the New Westminster district which he purchased this year for \$300. this land has not been cleared. The house in New Westminster in which his wife and children reside is rented and the contents in this owned by Fujinami amount to about \$350.

5. He acknowledges a personal loan to Masao Miyamoto (B.C. Ref. 935-731) of \$26. and states that there is an outstanding debt of about \$30. owing T. Maikawa & Co. Vancouver and about \$30. to the Union Fish Co. Vancouver.

6. An effort will be made to verify the information contained above at a later date in cooperation with the local representative of the Custodian of Alien Enemy Property.
