S. Pune owns a small form and house in Wakeyema, Japan. He has no property in Canada. He acknowledges the following debts - \$250. horrowed from his company, \$100. from his brother-in-law, J.ZASAKA at Skeens, B.C. and \$60. from S.HIGUCHI at Steveston, B.C.
