GENERAL SUMMARY

File No. 13829

November 9, 1946.

Re: Tomotaro NISHIMURA #04285

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on the 15th of March, 1943, approximately a year after his evacuation.

The only property reported in this declaration was the chattels (also reported by his wife), which had been removed to 992 Powell St. warehouse from 6457 Fraser Ave. A list of these chattels had been sent to Mrs. NISHIMURA at the time of removal to storage, and she had confirmed that these were all the chattels belonging to her remaining in the protected area. Chattels reported on this file and that of Mrs. Tomotaro NISHIMURA, File 10713, have been administered in File 10713. The net proceeds from the sale of chattels, identified as belonging to Mrs. NISHIMURA, amounted to \$65.31, and cheque for this sum has been requisitioned and will go to her within the next few days.

Cheque for \$318.00, payable to Tomotaro NISHIMURA, received from the Sun Life Assurance Company as cash surrender value of Policy No. 2,092,142, was sent to NISHIMURA on August 18, 1943.


