



This file reveals that YAMAMOTO owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire insurance.

CHATELS: YAMAMOTO made his declaration to the Custodian on May 18/43 and was evacuated on March 23/42. He declared chattels as shown on Chattel Schedule on file, at 977 W. 7th Ave.

A large quantity of chattels from this address were shipped to him as shown on Chattel Schedule on file.

One box of goods in the name of "S. YAMAMOTO" was removed from 756 W. 7th Ave., Vancouver. This is given by YAMAMOTO as his previous address. Since the only "S. YAMAMOTO's" living at this address were the wife and son of Tasaburo YAMAMOTO, and neither one of them declare any chattels, the proceeds from sale of contents of box in the sum of \$4.50 is being left in the account of Tasaburo YAMAMOTO.

In his letter of April 19/44 YAMAMOTO asked about sheet metal equipment left at 240 Main St. Mr. Spain in his letter of April 25/44 confirms that this equipment is still there, but the file does not indicate what disposition has been made of it. I have sent a memo to Mr. Wills asking him about this equipment.

The correspondence regarding this sheet metal equipment is on the wrong file. This letter of enquiry about this equipment should be on File 2977. This leaves everything accounted for on this file.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

There are only two S. YAMAMOTO'S listed at 756 W. 7th Ave., one is Shisue YAMAMOTO, wife of Tasaburo, and Shunzo, their son, and neither of these declared any chattels. It would therefore appear to be quite in order to leave this credit in the account of Tasaburo YAMAMOTO

In letter dated April 19/44 YAMAMOTO asks about sheet metal equipment left at 240 Main St. The file gives no indication as to the disposition of this equipment other than confirming that it is located at 240 Main St. I have sent a memo to Mr. Wills asking him about this equipment. This correspondence should be on file 2977, as it deals with equipment belonging to Tomokazu YAMAMOTO of 242 Main St.
