Dear Sir:

Your request for the return of your camera has been received. In reply, we wish to advise that it is our understanding that cameras and radios may be released to persons residing outside the restricted area and outside the interior housing settlements.

We suggest that you get in touch with the representative of the British Columbia Security Commission, who will be able to supply more complete information.

It will be necessary for you to supply the Commission with the receipt received from the police when the camera was surrendered, and to make arrangements for payment of the cost of packing and shipping.

We are returning to you, herewith, the receipt for your camera, which had been handed to a representative of the Custodian on May 28, 1942. This receipt reads as follows:
