No. 1. This claim was submitted to NOMURA on two occasions but no answer was received.


The creditors and the collecting agency were advised with address of debtor and informed that we would take no further action (Ltr. 23-11-43 and May 29/45).


The Prudential Insurance Company of America has reported the above mentioned policy.
