
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:

RE: Hisao KURIHARA - 09583.


This Japanese person did not declare any personal effects, nor does the file reveal any.

He possessed one share valued at \$10.00, in The United Farmers Co-operative Exchange of Mission, B.C., and this was redeemed by them on February 23rd, 1943 and the value, \$10.00, together with interest accrued - .80¢, forwarded to him on May 10th, 1943.

He declared that he had in his possession \$89.00 in War Savings Stamps and a Monarch Life Insurance Company Policy (no details). These did not come under the control of the Custodian.
