Dear Sir:

We are enclosing herewith a copy of our letter to you dated April 1st, 1943. We have not yet received a Declaration from you in connection with property, real or personal, owned by you before you left this area. Your wife, however, returned forms duly signed but this does not satisfy our office as far as you are concerned personally.

On April 25th, 1942, your wife, Nui Horibe, turned over to the Custodian a Dodge Sedan, registered in your name, which was later sold for \$1200.00. The proceeds from the sale, amounting to \$1138.35, were credited to an account opened in the name of your wife, due to the fact that you had failed to complete the Declaration forms which were sent to you.

It is our desire to keep you supplied with sufficient funds for your personal needs but we must have your co-operation at the same time. We, therefore, have to advise you that we cannot send further monies until such time as you send the Custodian at this office a receipt for the \$400.00 already forwarded, signed by you personally, and not by your wife. Further, we must have a letter from you authorizing us to keep your money in your wife's name and to make payments to her on your behalf.

On receipt of this receipt and letter a cheque will be sent to your wife for \$100.00.

We are again enclosing "JP" forms and we would be glad to have you complete same.
