

Re: Intermountain Guarantee Capital Limited.

Representatives from this office, visiting Tashme in connection with repatriation arrangements, returned to us our letter to you of the 21st February for the purpose of expediting, if possible, the distribution of the liquidated assets of the above Company.

On taking the matter up with the Liquidator, Mr. G. O. Cumpston, Victoria, he has replied as follows: "....I have to advise you that distribution of the assets of the above company is being delayed pending receipt of settlement from the Royal Trust Company in Vancouver in connection with the liquidation of the Intermountain Building & Loan Association...."

On communicating with the Royal Trust Company today, by telephone, we are advised that all assets of the Intermountain Building & Loan Association having been liquidated they are ready to proceed with the work of distribution as soon as they get clearance from the Income Tax authorities at Ottawa. They add the information that the amount available for distribution is small and is not expected to exceed .07¢ on the Dollar.

When a settlement is effected by Mr. Cumpston your account will be credited with your proportionate share of the assets of the Intermountain Guarantee Capital Limited (in Liquidation).
