GENERAL SUMMARY

File No. 13881

April 11, 1947

Re: Narabu SAKANASHI, Reg. No. 05912

On September 21, 1943, this man signed a declaration to the Custodian in which he stated that he owned no property of any kind in the protected area. Narabu SAKANASHI had been evacuated on March 23, 1942.

The file shows that the sum of \$3.90, being refund of one per cent wage deductions for 1941, was credited to the account of SAKANASHI and was remitted to him on January 21, 1944.

On December 31, 1946, SAKANASHI wrote us inquiring about a credit of \$161.08, which he stated he had in an account with M. Furuya Co. Ltd. On October 18, 1946, P. S. Ross & Sons sent to this office the sum of \$160.00 to be credited to N. SAKANASHI; this sum being a credit in an employe's account with M. Furuya Coy. Ltd. These funds were placed in the account of M. Furuya Co. until such time as N. SAKANASHI was identified, and are now being transferred to the account of Narabu SAKANASHI.

A claim was filed against Narabu SAKANASHI by Mrs. Toshiye Takahiro NONAKA for the sum of \$25.00. As this debt, according to the creditor, was 10 years old it would be outlawed. We wrote SAKANASHI about it but received no reply. On January 22, 1944, we supplied Mrs. NONAKA with the address of SAKANASHI and suggested that she get in touch with him. No further action by this office.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

This summary is certified to be in accordance with information on file.
