The deceased declared no assets to the Custodian and none appear on the file. It was learned from the Sun Life Assurance Company that the deceased's son, Kiichi, was insured under Sun Life Assurance Company policy #347344.

The only claim filed against the deceased is for the sum of \$50.00 to cover funeral expenses paid by the B. C. Security Commission for his burial. The Commission was advised that neither the deceased or his widow had any assets registered with the Custodian, from which payment of the claim might be made.

Dear Mr. Wright:

Re: Life Insurance.

On June 11th, 1946, you wrote in regard to a policy holder,
Shigeru Kawaguchi (In Japan):

"We note that you have not sufficient funds to pay the premium and that this policy will carry itself until August 1st, 1948. Under the circumstances it is advisable to let the matter stand, as it is not yet possible to establish survival or residence of the insured, or in the event that death has occurred, we cannot obtain evidence of survival of the beneficiary.

It is expected that in due time the insurance companies will be able to get the necessary information and in the meantime our rights are not prejudiced by inaction. All such cases should be tabulated for review in the course of the next year."

In regard to a policy left by a Japanese who has recently been repatriated, and who received an advance from the Department of Labour, on September 20th last you wrote:

"Pursuant to the provisions of Order-in-Council P.C. 7355 dated December 15th, 1945, real and personal property in Canada, left by repatriates, vests in the Custodian.

You refer to the fact that there is but \$3.00 at credit and the only remaining asset is a Life Insurance Policy, fully paid up, with an approximate value of \$2,160.00. The policy should be surrendered and the balance collected from the Insurance Company and placed to the credit of the

*insured.

When funds are received, the Department of Labour should be re-insured for the advance made and the balance will in due time be forwarded in accord with the terms of the Order-in-Council."

We have a present instance of a policy on the life of a Japanese in Japan whose Mother and Father were evacuees, the father being the beneficiary under the policy and who died at Tashme in 1944.

The Sun Life Assurance Company advise us that the cash surrender value of the policy is \$336.28 as at April 1st next and the amount to bring the overdue premiums up to date as at the same date is \$738.00, and if no payment at all is received, the policy will carry to maturity under the Automatic Premium Loan privilege.

We assume that it would be best to let this policy carry itself as at the moment we have no evidence as to whether the assured is alive and it would appear that the handling of a policy of this nature should remain in abeyance until information can be obtained from Japan.

Your comments would be appreciated.

We acknowledge with thanks your letter of August 5, 1949. We cannot gather from your letter whether the policy will carry itself to maturity and if so, the value it will have at that time, and would appreciate being advised.

With reference to the existence of the Assured, we will be pleased to know whether you have had any recent communication with him. If not, his mother, Mrs. Tsune Yoshida, New Denver, B.C., his only known living relative in Canada, might be able to give you some information in this regard. Our file indicates that Kiichi Yoshida's father died at Tashme, B. C. on April 11, 1944.

Kiichi Yoshida was born in Japan and appears to have been in Japan prior to the outbreak of war with that country. As suggested to your Mr. Irvine in a telephone conversation this morning, you might write to the External Affairs Department at Ottawa for directions concerning how the assured may be located.

The Custodian will be interested in any funds which may accrue to Kiichi Yoshida.
