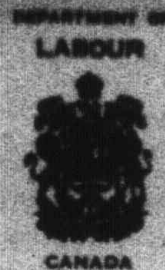

we quote a letter from Mrs. UYEHAMA dealing with the

present I am a bit short of money but as soon as I
am able I will pay the accounts of Matsu Tanaka and
Saijiro Wakita for the sum of \$84.14 and \$39.43 re-
spectively direct to them."

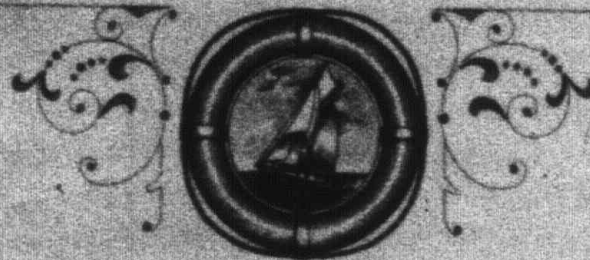
