
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:

The above Japanese person did not complete our JP Declaration Forms but signed under dates of November 24th, 1943 and February 2nd, 1944, our Form J card, certifying that he had no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area in British Columbia.

From a copy of a letter on file dated Feb. 13, 1943, it is revealed that the above Evacuee owed an amount of \$62.30 to the Globe Fertilizer Company Limited, payment for which was made from the brother's account at his request. No other indebtedness of the above Evacuee is revealed on this file.
