Specified Articles: There are no Cameras, radios, Fire Arms or Motor Vehicles revealed in the registration or the file.


Life Insurance: \$1,000.00 Dominion Life Insurance Co., Policy No. 173087 - in owner's possession. No action was required by the Custodian.

Re: Young Men's Buddhist Association.

Mr. Tsutao Sato who now lives at College Heights, Lacombe, Alberta, has recently been in Vancouver and has advised us that you are the present President of the above named association. If this is the case we wish to inform you that a movie projector machine bearing a tag with the name Young Men's Buddhist Association, R.C.M.P. No. 375, was delivered to the Custodian by the R.C.M.P. If this machine belongs to your society you will no doubt be able to produce the R.C.M.P. receipt.

This projector is at the present in the Hampa Buddhist Temple at 604 E. Cordova Street and this building has now been sold on the instructions of Mr. Kagetsu. The purchasers are desirous of taking possession of the building as soon as possible and we therefore request that if this article belongs to your society we be advised what disposition to make of it.

Eighteen judo mats were moved to 604 E. Cordova Street from 549 E. Cordova Street and these have been appraised and sold to the purchasers of the building together with a quantity of benches, tables and chairs the property of the Hampa Buddhist Temple. These mats were not marked with a name, but since we now understand that your society used 549 E. Cordova Street for its activities, it is possible that these mats belong to you and if so we will be pleased to credit your society with the proceeds.

The purchasers of the building have today inquired concerning buying the movie projector and we have told them that we will let them know as soon as we hear from the owners.



Attached is original bill of lading for two trunks
effects shipped from Vancouver January 4th on your Custodian
Release of June 30th, and pursuant to your letter of November
5th, on which we are paying the following charges:

Richmond Transfer, cartage & roping	\$2.50
C.P.R. freight	10.80
	<u>\$13.30</u>

This shipment weighed 270 lbs. and you shipped at our expense
from Esso when you evacuated in August, 1943, 117 lbs., which
makes a total of 387 lbs.

We would appreciate it if you would, however, reimburse
us for the \$2.50 paid the Richmond Transfer for cartage and
roping by sending a Money Order in favour of the Receiver General
of Canada to this office.

I suspect these trunks had been broken into at 604
Cordova. If you find anything missing, it is your privilege to
take up direct with the Custodian as that is a matter between you
and the Custodian and is entirely out of our jurisdiction.
