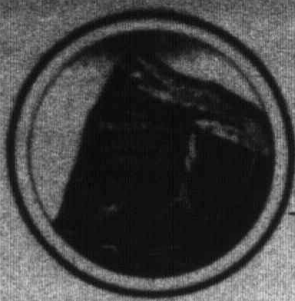

Under date of April 28, 1947 Mr. Itaro Horiguchi made application with our Company for the cash surrender value of the above numbered policies, which covered individuals resident in Japan, and on which policies he had paid the premiums.
