As requested in your letter of April 5th, we enclose herewith Custodian cheque in the amount of \$60.94, representing all the funds standing to your credit with this office.

These funds represent the net proceeds from the sale of the Elto Outboard motor which you surrendered to Naval Service in December, 1941.

Although we requested you to do so, you did not sign a declaration to the Custodian in regard to your property. The motor was the only item identified as your property of which this office has any record.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the cheque, we enclose a stamped, addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Masao YOSHITAKE Reg. No. 09754

This man was evacuated from the protected area on March 10, 1942. Although requested to do so on several occasions, he did not sign a declaration to the Custodian in regard to his property.

An Elto Outboard motor was turned over to the Custodian in April, 1943. This motor had been seized by Naval Service from M. YOSHITAKI, of Port Alice, in December, 1941. Masao YOSHITAKE is the only person from Port Alice with a name resembling that given by Naval Service. Masao YOSHITAKE, on April 5, 1946, wrote asking what had been done with his Elto Outboard engine. It would seem, therefore, that he is the owner of the engine. This engine was sold for the sum of \$66.00 by this office. Expenses amounted to \$5.06. The balance of \$60.94 was credited to the account of Masao YOSHITAKE.
